# Meet Sara our 60th award recipient

Sara was 17 years old, and entering her senior year of high school, when she applied for financial assistance in May of 2017.

She was seeking residential treatment and wrote about her passion and drive to recover.

She recently shared her journey and where life has taken her in the last six years.

"Throughout my high school years, I struggled greatly with an eating disorder. It quickly took over my life in a way that I needed a lot of outside help. Moonshadow's Spirit came into my life and helped me receive treatment.

Recovery absolutely changed my life. It was certainly difficult at first, but it opened my world to many different opportunities I never thought I would have.

Today, I consider myself fully recovered. I live with my partner of six years and enjoy living life to the fullest. I recently received my Master's in Clinical Mental Health Counselor to pursue a career as a therapist. This has been a dream of mine since I started my own recovery, and it has now become my reality.

To this day, I am still incredibly grateful to have received help from so many, including Moonshadow's Spirit (I, of course, still have the shawl!).

If there is a message I want anyone to take away from this, it is that recovery is worth it."

When Jennifer began full recovery, she shared her story by giving a presentation to high school students, and this is what we continue to do to this day.

## Why high schools?

- 11% of high school students suffer with an eating disorder; this increases to 13% for college students
- 12% of adolescent girls have some form of eating disorder

### DID YOU KNOW THAT IN THE UNITED STATES

- 28.8 million Americans will have an eating disorder in their lifetime
- Only **35-40%** of people with anorexia or Bulimia receive treatment
- Inpatient treatment typically costs up to \$60,000 for a 30 day program
- 10% of people with anorexia nervosa die from complications
- 10,200 deaths per year as a direct result of an eating disorder
- That equates to 1 death every 52 minutes
